



COMBAT RIFLE IMMERSION

Length

16.00 Hours

Description

This course is designed for individuals who carry a rifle for the purpose of self defense. Training encompasses the finer points of employment of a rifle under combat conditions where threats must be engaged quickly and with devastating accuracy. This course applies focus to speed and accuracy, as well as applying them under physical and mental stress. Using the crawl-walk-run method allows the student to refresh and progress, while exploring combat proven techniques.

Prerequisites

Students must be at least 18 years old (students under 18 must be accompanied by a legal guardian). Students must have legal residency within the United States (US citizen/US VISA), and must not be restricted from handling firearms or ammunition. Tactical Immersion will not perform training services for any individual deemed to be of questionable character or that may appear to have ties to a criminal organization.

Required Equipment

- Hearing protection, wrap around eye protection, billed cap.
- Knee and elbow Pads (recommended but optional).
- Magazine fed rifle with 3 magazines (5 magazines recommended) and 750 rounds of serviceable ammunition.



- Quality belt mounted magazine pouches.
- Quality rifle sling.
- Weather appropriate, sturdy clothing and good footwear such as hiking boots that provide good ankle support.
- Sunscreen, bug spray, drinking water and snacks are highly recommended.
- Athletic or medical tape for fingers and hands is also recommended.

Audience

This course is appropriate for law enforcement, military and civilian personnel.

Other Information

During this course students will be required to pass a practical exercise exam and combat pistol qualification course of fire.
